Dressing your Windows

New window coverings can do for a room what a new outfit can do for you. It offers an inexpensive way to change the look and atmosphere of a room by customizing it with your unique, personal taste. Here are a few things to keep in mind when choosing new drapes or blinds.

Style:

Blinds. Roman blinds are versatile, practical, and very popular in today's design trend for a cleaner, sleeker, uncluttered look. Many of the older homes in our neighbourhood have beautiful wooden trim framing the windows. Show off that trim with Roman blinds inside the frame.

Fabric:

Type. The choices are unlimited. For drapes, you can choose almost any type of fabric. For roman blinds, try to avoid stretchy fabrics that tend to sag, distracting from the neat, angular look.

Design. If you choose fabric with a pattern, remember to allow extra fabric for pattern matching. For roman blinds, avoid fabric with a large pattern or motif, as you will lose the effect of the pattern when the blind is pulled up.

Lining:

Lining protects your fabric from sunlight and provides a uniform, finished look to the exterior of your house. By choosing different types of lining,

room. Lining can also help shut out cold air and draughts that may come in through the window.
